Scholarship Application Rules & Regulations

- 1) BC Soccer will offer a minimum of three and a maximum of eleven scholarships for each scholarship year.
- 2) Scholarships shall be awarded by BC Soccer to any successful applicant who, for three or more years, has played with a team affiliated with BC Soccer and who is currently participating in some capacity in soccer; this may be as a player, referee, coach or administrator.
- 3) The qualifications of recipients have to be:
 - a) Proceeding from Grade 12 to any university in the province or other secondary institution approved by the Events Committee
or
Attending a post-secondary institute, but who are under 19 years of age as of January 1st, of the current application year
 - b) Must have a minimum of "B" average
 - c) Must have demonstrated good citizenship, personality and leadership
- 4) All applicants must follow the scholarship application process outlined in this policy in order to be considered for a BC Soccer Scholarship. BC Soccer reserves the right to forego processing any applications from applicants who do not follow the procedure outlined below.
- 5) The funds will be withheld until such time the recipient provides proof of payment of tuition either the first semester or in full as well as proof of enrolment that he/she is attending any post-secondary institute approved by the Events Committee.
- 6) A scholarship that is awarded, but not availed of within 3 years of the award winner's high school graduation year will be deemed to be null and void. The aforementioned scholarship award will be then awarded to a new candidate the following year.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- 7) All scholarship applications must be submitted no later than March 31st of each year.
- 8) All applications must contain three components:
 - a) Submit a completed application form
 - b) Three written references
 - i) If the applicant is currently in Grade 12 - A letter of reference from the principal or vice principal or academic advisor/counsellor certifying the candidate's age, character and ability, as well as participation in school activities.
Or
If the applicant is currently attending a post-secondary institute - A letter of reference from the principal or vice principal or academic advisor/counsellor from the secondary school the applicant graduated from certifying the candidate's age, character and ability, as well as participation in school activities.
 - ii) A letter of reference from a Youth District or Adult (Senior) League official or Club Head Coach/Technical Director or Club Head Referee **indicating the candidate's character, leadership examples, participation in community activities, as well as information regarding the candidate's soccer ability or contribution to refereeing, coaching or administrative involvement.**

- iii) A personal letter of reference from family friend, team head coach or teacher regarding the candidate's character.
- c) **Submit a transcript of the student's marks or a photocopy of the Permanent Record Card (if neither is available, a typed copy of the Permanent Record Card verified by the principal's or secondary administrator's signature will be accepted).**
