

BCCSL Information Memo – November 2017

The BCCSL Guide was posted on the BCCSL website pending approval by BC Soccer. The Guide is now officially approved with the following exceptions/additions/deletions in red:

Page 2, Welcome, top of middle column:

New teams entering the League after Thanksgiving movements have been made are not eligible for League Cup play as players must have played at least one League game before participating in Cup. See Page Error! Bookmark not defined., Registration.

Page 4, Communications – General, 2nd paragraph:

No member of the Board shall vote on any matter directly affecting him/herself or any club or team s/he is involved with.

Page 7, Standings & Changes to Leagues, bottom of middle column:

A League Schedulers' meeting will be held the Monday before Thanksgiving with teams being promoted or relegated based on the results of the games played up to Thanksgiving. Very high or low goal differences, as well as the League standing of the teams they have played against, will be the determining factors. The competition level for the majority of the teams in the grouping takes precedence over that of a single team.

BC Soccer would like the league to reconsider our method (present wording in green) so as to discourage running up the scores.

Page 9, BCSA Photo ID, 5th paragraph down in the first column:

BCSA The league mandates that while a team official has only one assigned "staff" number, they must have a validated BCSA photo ID specific to each team they coach.

THANKSGIVING PROMOTION/RELEGATION - clarification

There was a discussion regarding the Thanksgiving Promotion-Relegation process at a District Chairs' & Schedulers' meeting held in mid-September. At the November BCCSL Board meeting the issue of teams moving into new sections with the average points of that section was discussed and the board voted to not follow that process; instead all sections would start with a clean slate – zero points for every team.

Please get in touch with your BCCSL Board Rep and let them know if you are able to put in a 2-4 hour shift on one of the days.

West-side sections of teams are scheduled for Burnaby Lake West.

East-side sections will be scheduled at a location on the East-side – TBA.

SCHEDULING ISSUES: will go from the District Scheduler to the BCCSL Scheduling Secretary and forwarded by him to the BCCSL Head Scheduler.
