VANCOUVER YOUTH SOCCER ASSOCIATION POLICY REGARDING REQUESTING ADULT DISCIPLINE INFORMATION

The purpose of the Society is to foster, develop and govern the game of soccer within the City of Vancouver and the University Endowment Lands and to enforce the Constitution, Bylaws and Rules & Regulations of the British Columbia Soccer Association.

Personal information will only be collected, used and disclosed by Vancouver Youth Soccer to engage players, parents, directors, fans, coaches, officials and other volunteers in the programs and activities offered by BC Soccer and related organizations, meeting and maintaining the highest standard of sport programming consistent with the mandate and mission of Vancouver Youth Soccer.

WHO CAN APPLY? A Club President or Club Technical Director.

WHEN TO APPLY? When the adult first applies with the Club for a registered team official

position.

WHO TO APPLY TO? The applicable Vancouver District Discipline Chair.

INFORMATION REQUIRED? An email from the Club President or Club Technical Director and;

A *Club Team Official Application* form with the signature of the applying person giving permission for the District to divulge all discipline history

on record.

The applying team official should be made aware that by signing the *Club Team Official Application* form that s/he is agreeing to the sharing of discipline records including, but not limited to, ejection report penalties assessed; discipline results from protested games where they were found to be at fault; fines & performance bonds levied due to issues such as abandoned games where s/he was found to be at fault and long term suspensions.

The applicable Vancouver District Discipline Chair will forward the detailed information on record to the Club in a timely manner.

In the event that there is no discipline history on record this will also be communicated to the inquiring Club.
